

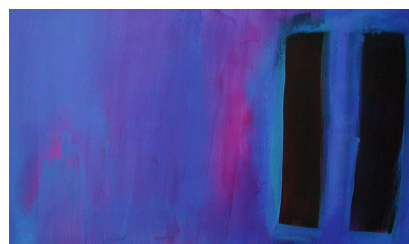
## Lynda Pogue's Serendipity Art Exhibit now extended to November 10th in Halton Hills



Toronto, 25 October 2013 - The Williams Mill Arts Centre in the picturesque Glen William hamlet in Halton Hills hosting the Serendipity exhibit of paintings and photography by artist, lecturer & ROM alumna Lynda Pogue has extended the popular event by another week.

The Serendipity exhibit explores the multiple facets of Pogue's style and her mastery of challenging techniques. Pogue is regularly exhibited in NYC's Chelsea art district and is also famous for her magazine articles in the US on the pairing of art and music featuring interviews with rock stars cum painters such as Tom Waits. Her Rothko-inspired series has earned her great reviews.

She has enjoyed a successful outlet for her ebullient creativity by lecturing at the university level and forming programs to help shape the minds of the next generation of artists to set flight. She was recently featured in the socialite JoLee magazine and has been doing the rounds with Toronto's lunch ladies as well as being invited to join the elite Heliconian Club in Yorkville.
